YOM TERUAH 2015 JAMIE MCNAB 14/9/15

We go round the Holy Days ... year after year ... year after year ... year after year. Because God knows that we need it.

That is deliberate. God wants to remind us. It keeps us with a good understanding of His blue print ... His plan of salvation.

Why are we here? Why are we keeping a church service? Because He demands that we meet Him on His Holy Day. But why? Just to make it inconvenient ... or to teach us important lessons? The appointed times of Jehovah God.

Today is The Feast of Trumpets. What is the meaning of this day?

Leviticus 23:1-2

And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The feasts of the Lord, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts. (Appointed times)

These are God's Feast Days!!! The belong to Him. We ought to respect them.

What if the world just believe this one verse?

Leviticus 23:4

"These are the feasts of the Lord, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times.

Leviticus 23:23-25

The Feast of Trumpets

Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets,

(Teruah ... a shout or a loud blast) a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the Lord."

Leviticus 23:24 NET

"Tell the Israelites, 'In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you must have a complete rest, a memorial announced by loud horn blasts, a holy assembly.

Teruah ... with two meanings:

A loud blast of war and alarm

A shout or loud blast of joy and rejoicing

Numbers 29:1

"And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work. For you it is a day of blowing the trumpets. (Only 2 words in Hebrew: Yom Teruah ... Day of the loud blasts)

NB Rosh Hashanah is in Israel the Chief of The Year ... the start of the civil new year. Typically when a new king would start his reign.

- 1. The alarm ... shout of war
- 2. The shout of joy and rejoicing
- 3. How it applies to you and me ... today ... to wake up

THE ALARM OF WAR

There have been plenty of wars. In the last 3,400 years of recorded history there have been only 268 entirely peaceful years. Unfortunately, the news is ... there is much more to come. Teruah warns us of what is to come.

Jeremiah 4:5-8

Declare in Judah and proclaim in Jerusalem, and say:

"Blow the trumpet in the land; (shofar)

Cry, 'Gather together,'

And say, 'Assemble yourselves,

And let us go into the fortified cities.'

Set up the standard toward Zion.

Take refuge! Do not delay!

For I will bring disaster from the north,

And great destruction." (horrible calamities coming on the people)

The lion has come up from his thicket,

And the destroyer of nations is on his way.

He has gone forth from his place

To make your land desolate.

Your cities will be laid waste,

Without inhabitant.

For this, clothe yourself with sackcloth,

Lament and wail.

For the fierce anger of the Lord Has not turned back from us.

Jeremiah 4:19-21

O my soul, my soul!

I am pained in my very heart!

My heart makes a noise in me;

I cannot hold my peace,

Because you have heard, O my soul,

The sound of the trumpet, (shofar)

The alarm of war.

Destruction upon destruction is cried,

For the whole land is plundered.

Suddenly my tents are plundered,

And my curtains in a moment.

How long will I see the standard,

And hear the sound of the trumpet?

Jeremiah 6:1

"O you children of Benjamin,

Gather yourselves to flee from the midst of Jerusalem! (NET BIBLE: run for safety)

Blow the trumpet in Tekoa,

And set up a signal-fire in Beth Haccerem;

For disaster appears out of the north,

And great destruction.

Jeremiah 6:16-20

Thus says the Lord:

"Stand in the ways and see,

And ask for the old paths, where the good way is,

And walk in it;

Then you will find rest for your souls.

But they said, 'We will not walk in it.'

Also, I set watchmen over you, saying,

'Listen to the sound of the trumpet!'

But they said, 'We will not listen.'

Therefore hear, you nations,

And know, O congregation, what is among them.

Hear, O earth!

Behold, I will certainly bring calamity on this people—

The fruit of their thoughts, (their plans)

Because they have not heeded My words

Nor My law, but rejected it.

For what purpose to Me

Comes frankincense from Sheba,

And sweet cane from a far country?

Your burnt offerings are not acceptable,

Nor your sacrifices sweet to Me." (Empty worship ... it means nothing to God)

Jeremiah 6:22-23

Thus says the Lord:

"Behold, a people comes from the north country,

And a great nation will be raised from the farthest parts of the earth.

They will lay hold on bow and spear; (tanks and armoured vehicles)
They are cruel and have no mercy;
Their voice roars like the sea;
And they ride on horses,
As men of war set in array against you, O daughter of Zion."

Ezekiel 33:1-9

Again the word of the Lord came to me, saying, "Son of man, speak to the children of your people, and say to them: 'When I bring the sword upon a land, and the people of the land take a man from their territory and make him their watchman, when he sees the sword coming upon the land, if he blows the trumpet and warns the people, then whoever hears the sound of the trumpet and does not take warning, if the sword comes and takes him away, his blood shall be on his own head. He heard the sound of the trumpet, but did not take warning; his blood shall be upon himself. But he who takes warning will save his life. But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet, and the people are not warned, and the sword comes and takes any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at the watchman's hand.' "So you, son of man: I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore you shall hear a word from My mouth and warn them for Me. When I say to the wicked, 'O wicked man, you shall surely die!' and you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. Nevertheless if you warn the wicked to turn from his way, and he does not turn from his way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul.

Ezekiel addresses the House of Israel 82 times and The House of Judah only 6 times. (They House of Israel had already gone into captivity about 120 years earlier). So Ezekiel's message is probably for us today. Is this message to the modern day Israel?

Zephaniah 1:2-3

"I will utterly consume everything From the face of the land," Says the Lord;
"I will consume man and beast;
I will consume the birds of the heavens,
The fish of the sea,
And the stumbling blocks along with the wicked.
I will cut off man from the face of the land,"
Says the Lord.

Zephaniah 1:7

Be silent in the presence of the Lord God; For the day of the Lord is at hand, For the Lord has prepared a sacrifice; He has invited His quests.

Zephaniah 1:14-18

The great day of the Lord is near;
It is near and hastens quickly.

The noise of the day of the Lord is bitter; There the mighty men shall cry out. That day is a day of wrath, A day of trouble and distress,

A day of devastation and desolation,

A day of darkness and gloominess,

A day of clouds and thick darkness,

A day of trumpet and alarm (shofar and Teruah)

Against the fortified cities

And against the high towers.

"I will bring distress upon men,

And they shall walk like blind men,

Because they have sinned against the Lord;

Their blood shall be poured out like dust,

And their flesh like refuse."

Neither their silver nor their gold

Shall be able to deliver them

In the day of the Lord's wrath;

But the whole land shall be devoured

By the fire of His jealousy, For He will make speedy riddance Of all those who dwell in the land.

There is a strong hint that we are talking of worldwide destruction.

Zephaniah 3:8

"Therefore wait for Me," says the Lord,
"Until the day I rise up for plunder;
My determination is to gather the nations

To My assembly of kingdoms,
To pour on them My indignation,
All My fierce anger;
All the earth shall be devoured

With the fire of My jealousy.

But .. Is there an offer of protection for some people?

Zephaniah 2:1-3

Gather yourselves together, yes, gather together,

O undesirable nation,

Before the decree is issued,

Or the day passes like chaff,

Before the Lord's fierce anger comes upon you,

Before the day of the Lord's anger comes upon you!

Seek the Lord, all you meek of the earth,

Who have upheld His justice.

Seek righteousness, seek humility.

It may be that you will be hidden

In the day of the Lord's anger.

Let's look at The New Testament. There are some very special trumpets ... but not Teruah.

Trumpets ... Greek =Salpigx

Revelation 8:1-2

When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets.

Is it good news or bad news?

Revelation 8:6-13

So the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

First Trumpet: Vegetation Struck

The first angel sounded: And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. And a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.

Second Trumpet: The Seas Struck

Then the second angel sounded: And something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. And a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Third Trumpet: The Waters Struck

Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

Fourth Trumpet: The Heavens Struck

Then the fourth angel sounded: And a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night. And I looked, and I heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, "Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!"

There's worse coming.

Revelation 9:1-12

Fifth Trumpet: The Locusts from the Bottomless Pit

Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit. And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. And they were not given authority to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man. In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them.

The shape of the locusts was like horses prepared for battle. On their heads were crowns of something like gold, and their faces were like the faces of men. They had hair like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' teeth. And they had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the sound of chariots with many horses running into battle. They had tails like scorpions, and there were stings in their tails. Their power was to hurt men five months. And they had as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, but in Greek he has the name Apollyon. (A demon king over them)

One was is next Rehald still two

One woe is past. Behold, still two more woes are coming after these things.

Revelation 9:13-21

Sixth Trumpet: The Angels from the Euphrates

Then the sixth angel sounded: And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind. Now the number of the army of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard

the number of them. And thus I saw the horses in the vision: those who sat on them had breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow; and the heads of the horses were like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and brimstone. By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed—by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which came out of their mouths. For their power is in their mouth and in their tails; for their tails are like serpents, having heads; and with them they do harm.

But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.

Part 2 of Yom Teruah also pictures a time of shouting for joy and rejoicing. Today pictures ... when Jesus becomes the King Of Kings ... King of this world and His Kingdom is established.

We have seen 6 trumpets ... now on to the 7th trumpet ... the last one!!

Revelation 11:15-18

Seventh Trumpet: The Kingdom Proclaimed

Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!" And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God, saying:

"We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty,

The One who is and who was and who is to come,

Because You have taken Your great power and reigned.

The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come,

And the time of the dead, that they should be judged,

And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great,

And should destroy those who destroy the earth."

At the blowing of the seventh trumpet brings the fulfilment of all of the Old Testament prophecies. This is the best news that mankind could ever hear.

Daniel 7:13-14

"I was watching in the night visions,

And behold, One like the Son of Man,

Coming with the clouds of heaven!

He came to the Ancient of Days, (Jesus coming to The Father)

And they brought Him near before Him.

Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom,

That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.

His dominion is an everlasting dominion,

Which shall not pass away,

And His kingdom the one

Which shall not be destroyed.

Daniel 7:27

Then the kingdom and dominion,

And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven,

Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. (The saints

share in the administration of God's Government)

His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom,

And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'

Matthew 24:14-16

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

"Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation,' spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place" (whoever reads, let him understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

Matthew 24:21-22

For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

Matthew 24:29-31

"Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. (A real shout for joy!!)

1 Thessalonians 4:13-17

But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus.

For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. (As Jesus returns ... a great shout of joy)

1 Corinthians 15:50-54

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the

trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

Then Part 3. For you and me ... every year is a time to awake up and be ready.

For some reason ... the saints are going to find it difficult to be ready.

Mark 13:24-27

"But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven.

Mark 13:28-31

The Parable of the Fig Tree

"Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender, and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see these things happening, know that it is near—at the doors! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

Mark 13:32-37

"But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. Take heed, watch and pray; (Beware!!

Be alert!) for you do not know when the time is. It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his work, and commanded the doorkeeper to watch. Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming—in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the

morning—lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping. And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!"

Luke 12:35-40

"Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; (be ready and alert) ... at all times!!) and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."

Matthew 25:1-13

"Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish. Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. (Spiritually slumbering!!)

"And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!' Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.' And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut. "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.' "Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming. (Watch therefore = STAY AWAKE! DON'T GO

TO SLEEP!!!)

Luke 21:29-36

Then He spoke to them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees. When they are already budding, you see and know for yourselves that summer is now near. So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near. Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." (Watch Therefore! KEEP ON THE ALERT. Pray ALWAYS!!)

Yom Teruah for us is a wake up call for us each year!

Romans 13:11-14

And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, (His values) and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

Is this the final generation? It is OURS!

Today is the first day of Tishri ... beginning of the Autumn Holy Day Season ... is a shout ... a Teruah ... to wake up ... be alert ... be prepared for alarm of war ... be ready to shout for joy as God's Kingdom begins.
